Dear Members of the Body of Christ who are caught up in the cares of heaven and NOT the cares of this world, Thank you again for your precious gifts of love. You have learned very well, as I have, to put your investments into the eternal things of heaven, which have the greatest return of all!!

The coats and blankets that you trusted into our care, to get to the Seri Indians, have been delivered. The mission was a great victory, but not without some warfare from the enemy!! Some of you realize that taking used clothing into Old Mexico is contraband and the penalty could mean confiscation of your vehicle and going to jail! Regardless of why a law was made to stop poor people from getting the warm clothing they need, it is still classified as contraband and illegal. And part of the cost is realizing that the powers of darkness helped man put such and Anti-Christ law into place.

As Pat Poe and I crossed the border with nearly a ton of used clothing, we were stopped and searched. The guards told us that it was illegal to bring this into their country and then they had to make a decision of what to do about it. They finally decided to let us turn around and go back across the border. So, not being deterred from our mission by Satan we immediately went to a different border crossing about a mile to the west. Again were stopped and searched and told that it was illegal to take this used clothing into their country. It was amazing what their eyes saw and what my eyes saw. I saw your gifts of love that you were investing into the Kingdom of God. How glorious it is to be born of the Spirit of Jesus Christ!! And again they had to make a decision as to what they were going to do about it. Unlike the first time, these guards decided that they would take us to the Aduana, (Customs agent). What this really meant was that the worst was about to happen. So I gave Pat half the money we had and told him that if we got separated to use it to try and get back to his family. Pat knew by the look in my eyes and the sound of my voice that I may have to go to jail. I had already told him that if this did happen that the Lord knew there would be someone in that jail that I was supposed to minister to. Then the Lord led me to ask the guard a question. I said, "How much do you think the fine will be?" He then said, "Oh, are you willing to pay money to get these clothes through?" "Yes," I said, " these poor people are worth much more then money," hoping to touch his heart. So he then asked if I would be willing to pay a hundred dollars to him and another hundred dollars down at the twelve-mile checkpoint as well? I said, " Of course!!" So that is what happened and we finally made it through. Praise our Lord Jesus Christ and all His Power!!!

A few days before, there had been an awful storm in the desert that we had to drive across, and the sand had filled the low places making it nearly impassable, sometimes as much as three feet deep. We were advised by some locals to not try it. Of course Pat and I were not willing to let Satan have a victory over us and stop the completion of our mission! We plunged on ahead and yes, we did get stuck in the sand, but with a few hours of hard work digging out the truck and trailer we finally did arrive in the Seri Indian village of Desemboque!! Glory to God!! And, oh how happy these men, women and children were to see us and receive the warm clothing!! It had already gotten cold enough for blankets and coats at night, so this was the perfect time to take them! God it always right! Bless each one that gave of your clothing, your finances, and your prayers to help make this trip possible. We ministered every night with films on the end times and preaching, to get the people ready for what is coming upon the church in these ends times. We also ministered in the Mexican fishing village of Puerto Libertad, where Betty and I lived twelve years ago when we first began this work with the Seri Indians. God blessed there also and we had great victory and many souls saved. Hallelujah!!

We noticed that there were a lot of soldiers and marines in this village, more then usual, and we discovered that Mexico had raised their electric prices 1000 percent and they were anticipating protests because of it. The Lord led us to go ahead and leave that country and since then we have heard about riots, protests, burning of properties and such, as the people are very unhappy with their government. Pray for Mexico, as this will mean more poverty and suffering for those that are already poor and suffering.

A trip like this always comes with not only great blessing and victory in the Spirit, but with physical consequences also. The trips through the desert with such a heavy load in our little travel trailer nearly destroyed it. There is a lot of damage to repair, and also my truck gave me problems. The fuel pump again went out and I had a hard time getting home even after I was towed in and had a new fuel pump put in. The truck still kept stopping every few feet or every few miles. At least 100 times I had to get out and crawl under the truck to do what I could to get it started again. Through this and with Betty's and all of your prayers I finally did make is home yesterday!! I can tell you that God burned off every ounce of flesh I had!! And boy

did I learn the meaning of patience!! God is so good though, He was with me through it all and all the trials are worth what was accomplished for God's glory!! He will provide for the repairs too!! Or a new trailer and truck.

Now! Betty and I have great news to share with you all. Our son, Vaughn, his wife Irene, his daughter, Esther (15yrs), and his two sons, Ephraim (11yrs.) and Benjamin (3mos.) are now returning to the full-time ministry with us. They have played an administrative and support roll in Frontier Ministries for many years, but will now be joining with us in the active, hands-on part of the ministry. This has come about after many months of prayers and seeking God's guidance and we have all come to one accord in this decision! PTL! So, what this means is that you will be seeing Vaughn and Irene and family with us in our meetings and they will also be going with us on some of the mission trips. Such as, Vaughn and I are planning, the Lord willing, to make a trip back down to Brazil to the Amazon jungle in February. We will be going to the Wai Wai tribe, of which Irene is a member and her father, Asado, is the chief. They have suffered great economic and physical hardships these past few years and they need help and encouragement. Please remember them and this trip in your prayers. We are so happy to have Vaughn and Irene and children back onboard full-time again, as they have always been a great asset to this ministry and will be more so in the future. We know you all will love to get to know them too. Vaughn has a wonderful gift of teaching the Bible and of counseling also. You will all benefit from his knowledge in the Lord!

Also, Vaughn and I, along with Mike Murski will be making a trip to southern Mexico, Belize and Guatemala in December. We will be visiting works that Betty and I and our family started in those areas some 20 years ago and also going to new places with the Gospel. We will be traveling in our truck with the little 10ft. Travel-trailer again. We will be taking all our ministry equipment, including films, so that we can minister every place we stop. We all are excited about all the Lord will do and the new souls that will be added to the Kingdom in three countries! Glory to God! Please remember to pray for this trip also. Thank you!

We look forward to seeing a lot of you at our meetings the month of October, just a few days from now. We can't wait to share face to face with you of all that God has done and is going to do through this ministry. Each of you has a part in it all, as you pray for us and support us financially. We covet your prayers for an increase in the finances now with another family becoming involved. We have no doubt that God will supply our every need, just as we always pray that God does the same for you. We, all together will further the work of the Lord and see souls added to the Kingdom of God! What better treasure is there to store up in heaven than the soul of another person?!!! Hallelujah! We love you all and lift you up to God's throne often, and we are deeply thankful for your remembering us also. Until next time, God bless you all!!
